# STEP 1 Main Contents

1. improved navigation: never lose your context again after drill-down into an article
2. introducing the new Network Builder for easier management of related items
3. removing content preview from list-type views (new preview in Steps 2 and 3)
4. still using the old content full view layouts

Today, **content preview** is on the right side panel.

After opening the **item full view** it's sometimes hard to navigate back.

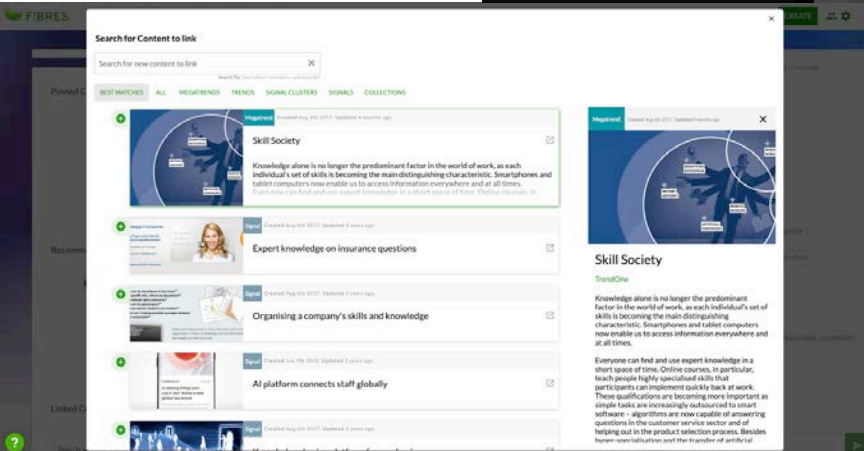
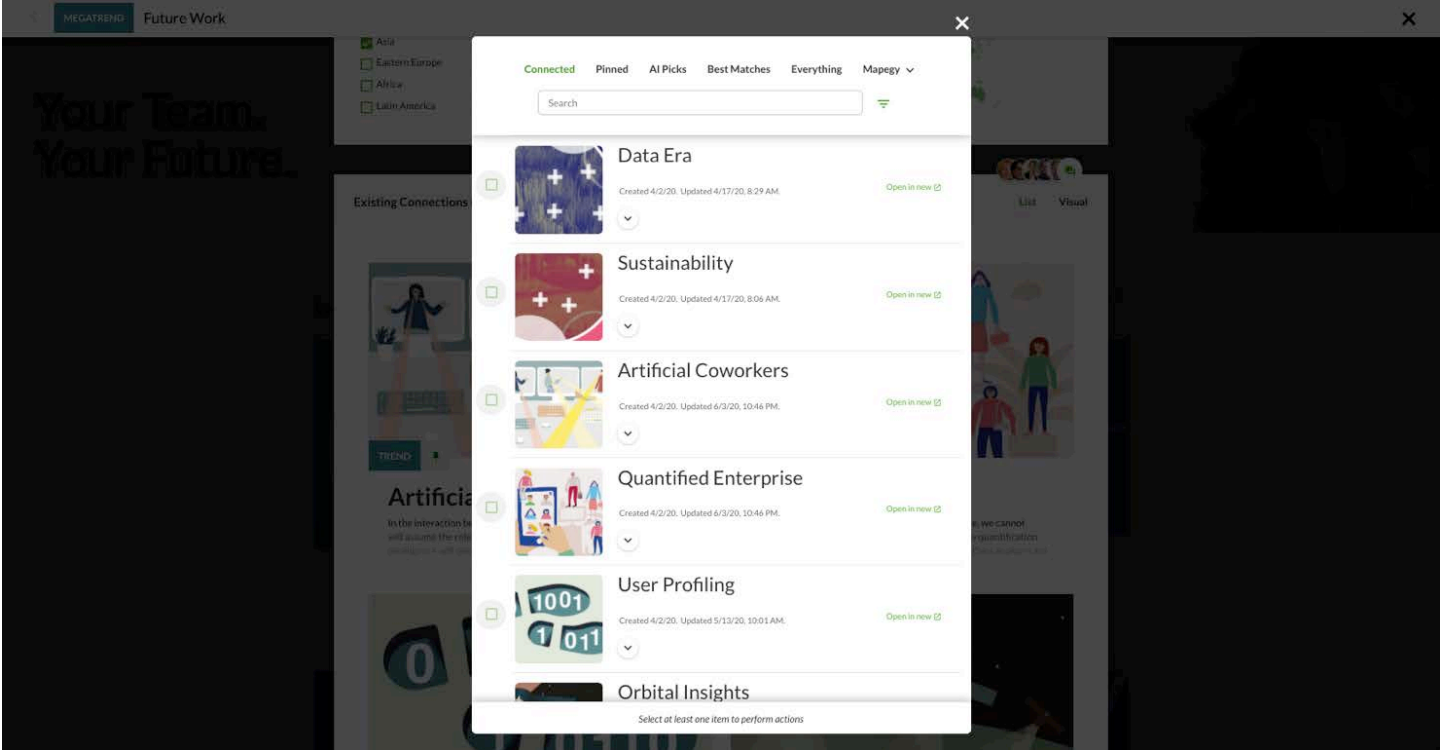


After renewal Step 1, an item opens **on top of your previous context**. It's easy to go back where you started from.

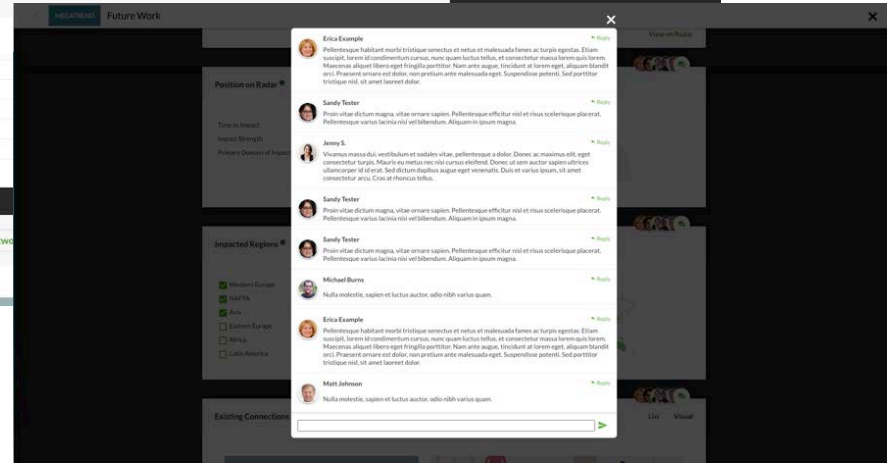
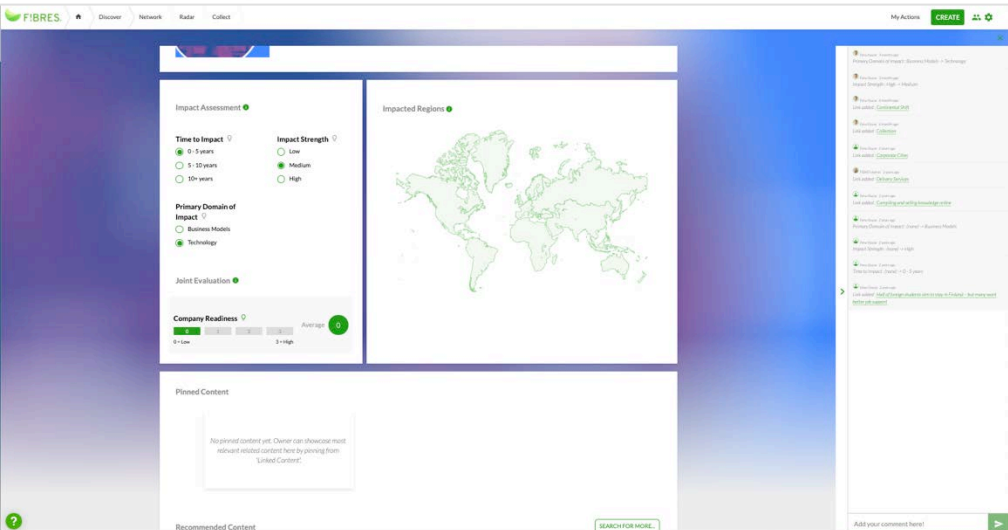
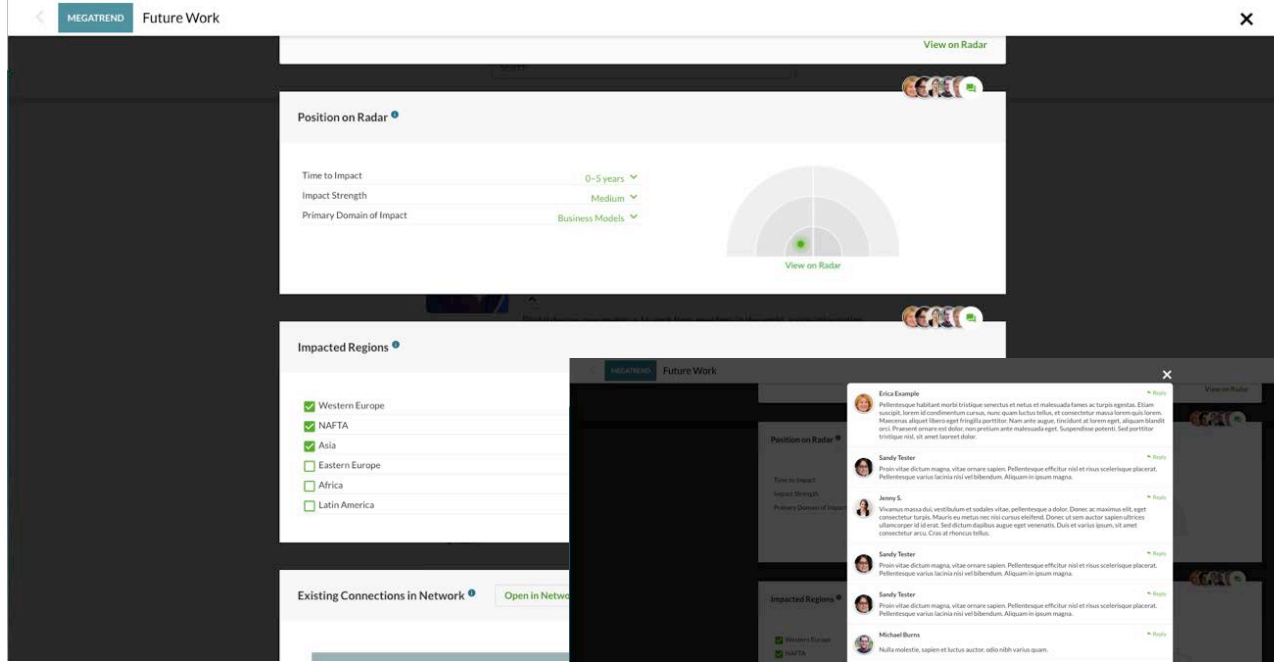
